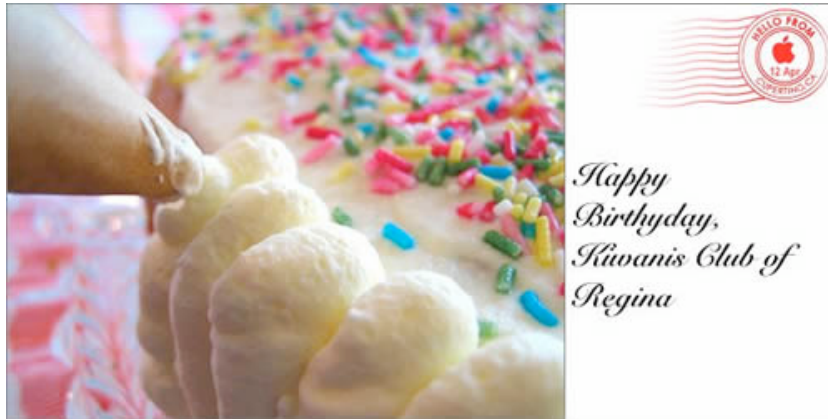

KIWANIS CHARTER

Steps have been taken to ensure that if we are hit by earthquake, volcanic ash plume, tornado, forest fire, tsunami, hurricane or bubonic plague, we might not survive, but our HISTORIC CHARTER will, in all likelihood, live on, forever. Extraordinary measures have been taken:

- several duplicates have been made and are in several hands
- one duplicate has been matted and framed behind plexiglass for display
- Trevor Quinn has had a custom box handcrafted from exotic woods to protect the display CHARTER
- a high resolution TIFF scan has been made and burned to several CDs and stored in several places
- the scanned image has been installed on our [website](#) server in Chicago, IL
- finally, the original HISTORIC CHARTER has been delivered to the conservator, Brenda Smith, at the Norman MacKenzie Gallery. She will rescue the artifact from the eight and a half decades of neglect and abuse it has endured while it was in our hands. We will then donate it to the **Saskatchewan Archive** where it will be kept safe *as long as there are people*. If only we could look after ourselves as well as this.
